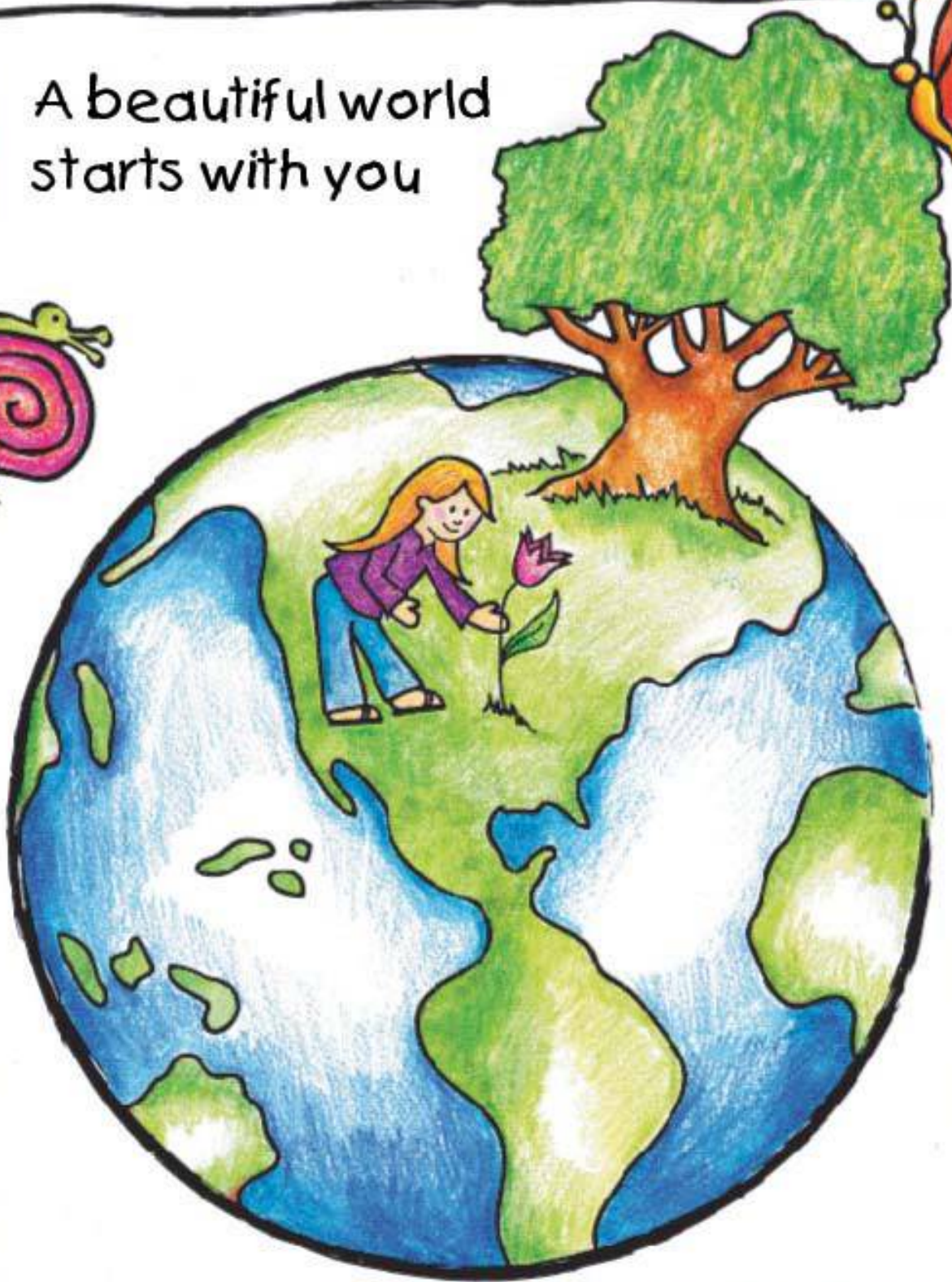

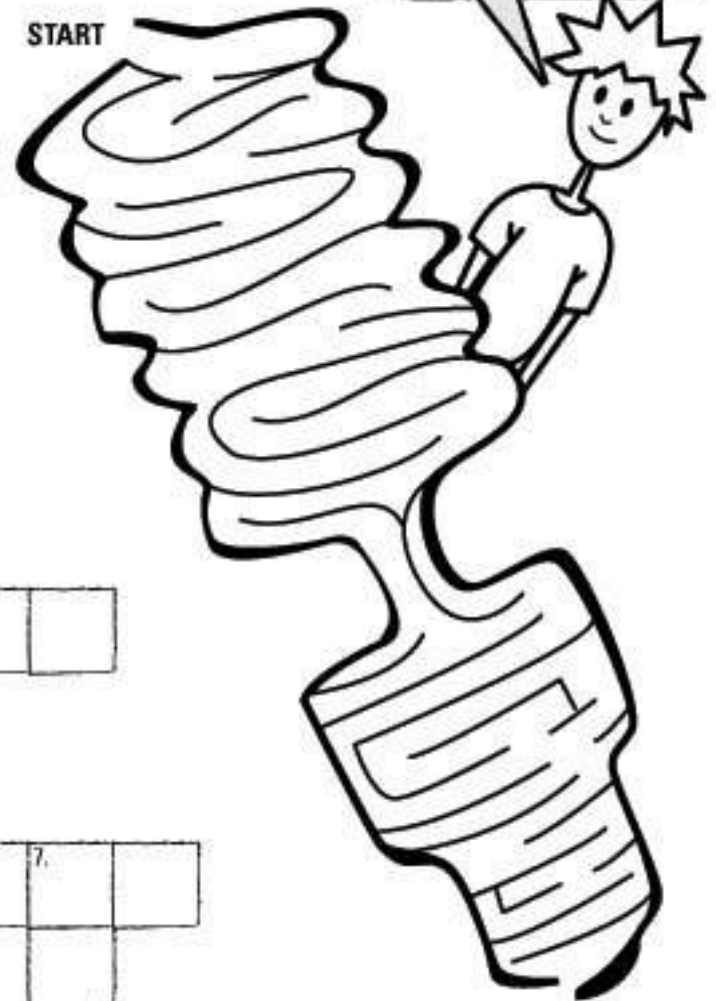

Materials

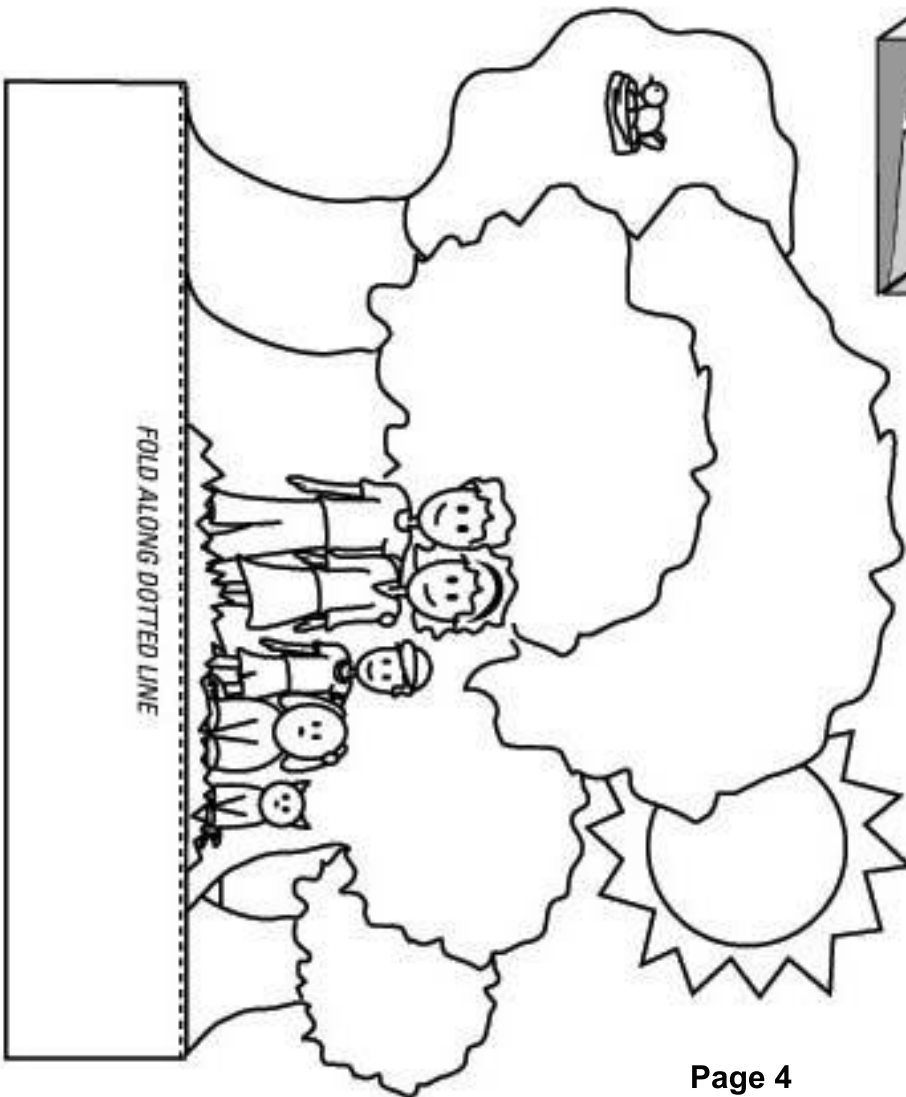
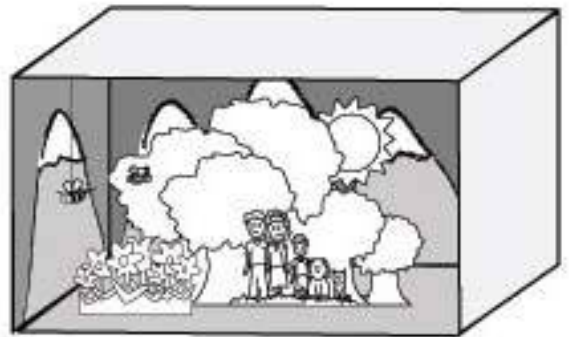
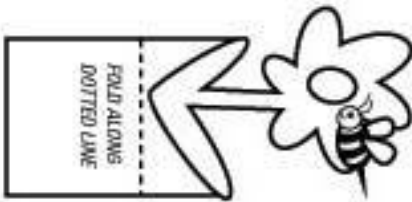
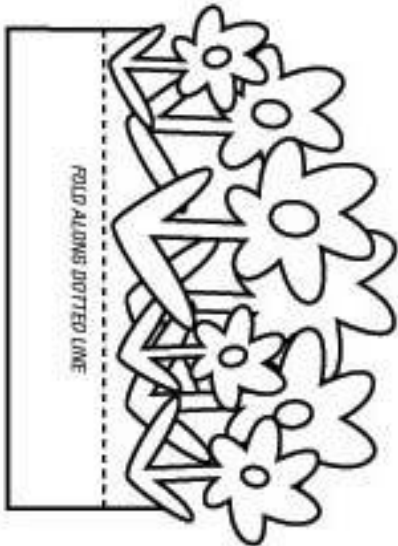
- construction paper

- leaves, grass, items from nature for extra effects

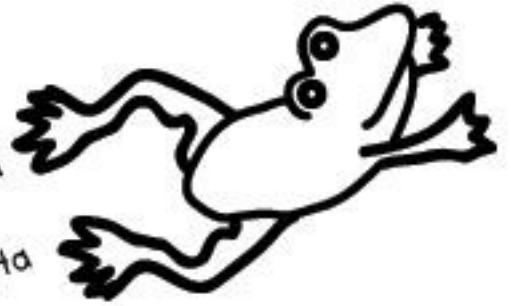
Directions

Step 1 Cut a piece of paper to fit the bottom and sides of the shoe box. The shoe box will be displayed on the long side so the bottom of the box will be the back of your scene. Draw hills, mountains, or anything else you would like for your background. Paste the paper to the inside of the box.

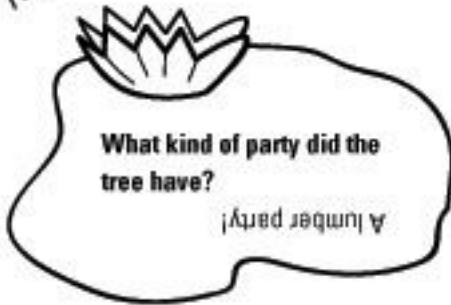
Step 2 Color and carefully cut out the trees and other shapes or make your own. Fold the bottom of the paper to make them stand.

Step 3 After you have several pictures standing, glue your pictures into the box to create a beautiful nature scene. You can also add things from nature for the finishing touches.

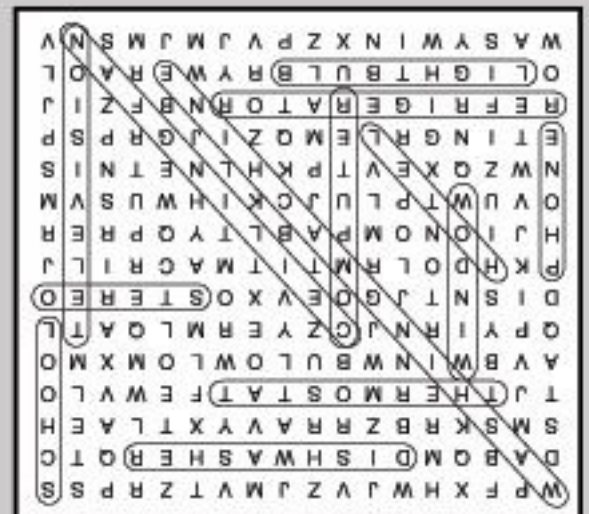
